Done so far in 2006

- Activated list-serve with the help of Paul Nowak.
- Sent a letter to all Sustainability Education Commission members encouraging them to submit proposals for the St. Paul Conference.
- Wrote and sent a letter to the U.S. Partnership for the Decade of ESD inviting the membership to submit proposals for the St. Paul Conference. (The letter went to the list serve and onto the Web site.)
- Activated Committee to create commission submissions to the Call for Presentations for the 2006 conference.
- Committee proposed: 1 pre-conference workshop, one post conference workshop, one symposium, several round table discussions, and two field trips.

Planning to do in 2006

- Write a letter to all SEC members asking for volunteers to sit on NAAEE committees.
- Make committee appointments and notify HQ.
- Create a survey to characterize the professional development need of the 3,500 members of the U.S. Partnership for the DESD.
- Work with Paul Nowak to implement the survey.
- Analyze the survey results.
- Using the survey results, establish short, medium, and long-range goals for the SEC to address professional development needs of SEC members and sustainability education community in North America.
- Strategize ways to leverage SEC activities to build NAAEE membership.
- Create and implement a campaign for sustainability educators to come to the St. Paul conference.
- Call for nominations for Chair Elect.
- Hold elections.
