

**NAAEE International Commission Travel Scholarship
38th Annual NAAEE Conference
Portland, Oregon
October 7-10, 2009**

Thank you for your interest in the International Commission Travel Scholarship. The scholarship provides travel assistance for conference delegates from countries other than Canada, Mexico, and the USA (preference will be offered to delegates from developing countries) to attend the 38th Annual NAAEE Conference in Portland, Oregon, October 7-10, 2009. Eligible candidates have been accepted to present at the conference and are environmental educators, students (not academics), and/or NGO representatives. Willingness to participate in International Commission (IC) events and activities during the conference and maintenance of an active membership of NAAEE and the IC for the remainder of the year is desirable.

Award: \$500.00 per recipient.

Requirements:

- * International NAAEE conference registrant
- * Presenting at conference
- * Not from Canada, Mexico or the USA
- * Preference given to a citizen of a developing country
- * Must be a student, NGO representative, and/or environmental educator (not an academic)
- * Must be able to demonstrate financial need
- * Preference given to those who are willing to participate in IC work

You will be asked to provide the following information:

1. Name
2. Contact information including e-mail (notification will be via e-mail)
3. Description of experience as an environmental educator
4. Description of how you can assist the IC (how will you use your experiences from NAAEE upon your return?)
5. Description of presentation abstract
6. If awarded a scholarship, will you be actively involved with NAAEE's International Commission?
7. If awarded a scholarship, will you be willing to participate in IC events and activities during the conference?

Evaluation: All applications will be reviewed by the IC Chair(s) and past IC Chair(s)

Deadline: Applications must be received no later than **July 30, 2009**. Applicants will be notified by email in August.
